



Field 41 Pale Ale

Year-round availability (1/6ths, 1/2s, and 6-packs)

Field 41 Pale Ale is named for the hop field that is home to Bale Breaker Brewing Company. It is one of the original flagship beers and was designed to be a low alcohol option for the hoppy beer drinker. It is available on tap at both Safeco Field and Century Link. While we describe this beer as a Pale Ale, some people would call it a Session IPA.

Hop Field #41 used to be owned by Alexander Graham Bell and his family. They used it as a test plot for different crops—including hops, apples, tobacco, and marijuana. Now, Field 41 is home to experimental, high-alpha bittering hop, HBC 682.

Tasting Notes: Medium aroma intensity. Malt and hops are well balanced with primary flavors of citrus, bready malt, and floral notes. May include fruity, pine, and grassy aromas. Present but smooth bitterness. Thin, dry, and drinkable.
