



Leota Mae IPA

Year-round availability (1/6ths, 1/2s, and 6-packs)

Leota Mae IPA is the newest addition to the year-round Bale Breaker stable. This beer was inspired by Leota Mae Loftus, the matriarch of the Loftus Family, who first planted hops in Moxee in 1932. Described as “a force to be reckoned with” and “a woman before her time”, it never occurred to Leota Mae Loftus that there was a job she couldn’t do. While this is another IPA, it differs greatly from Topcutter. Leota Mae is lower in ABV and IBU but has a slightly larger dry-hop bill.

Tasting Notes: Medium-high aroma intensity. Hops are very dominant with primary aromas of berry, tropical fruit, herbal, and pine. Pronounced flavor intensity, with hops again dominating. Flavors of grass, resin, fruity, and dank. Very little malt aroma or flavor. Intense bitterness with very dry character and medium body.
